Reminder that Executive Committee Meeting is April 12th at 6:00 and the General meeting is April 13th at 6:00.

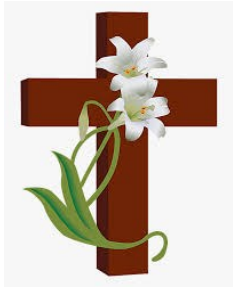
